



# Sample Town Maps



## How to use trees4humans.com sample town maps:

1. You can print one or more town map samples to use as needed and to write directly on the map(s). Be sure to print in LANDSCAPE for the full page images you will need of the maps. Your maps can be as simple as you want.
2. Look at the individual sample maps to make a list of what type buildings you would like to include on your map. Then, then draw a map by hand that shows your version of a town or community powered by renewable energy sources.
3. The renewable energy resources that will work best for most buildings/sections of your map are: solar, wind, biomass and geothermal.
4. Label the buildings/sections to show clearly the type of building or section of your map. E.g., school, hospital, grocery and other stores, restaurant/fast food, library, sport stadium, park, airport, train or bus station, homes, etc.
5. You can write on your town map showing the type of renewable energy source you decide works best for each building or section of your town/community map.
6. You don't need to identify an alternative energy source for all of the items/buildings on your map.
7. It would be helpful to add a 'key' to your map. A 'key' is a small box drawn/written on the map with a number or letter that relates to a specific building/location and states the type of alternative energy source to be used for a specific building/location.
